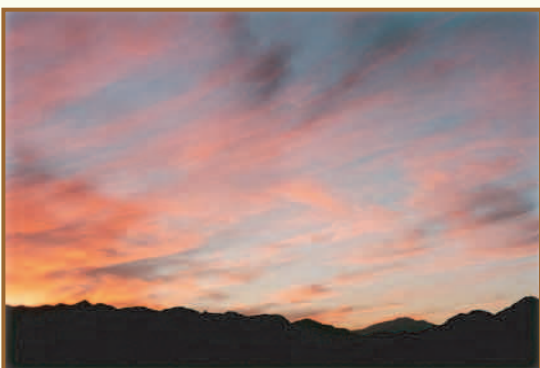

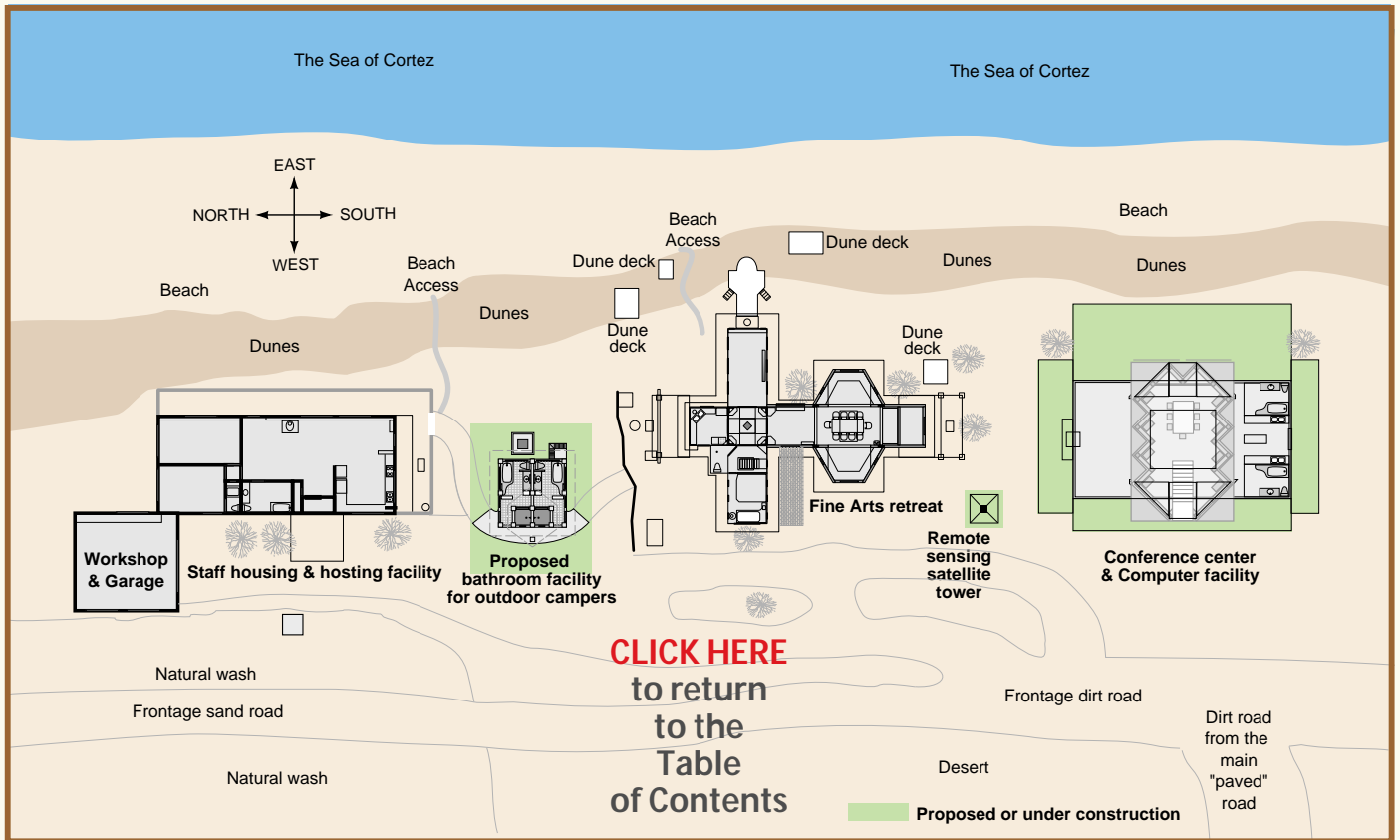
## The Casa de Claro environment



These are all photos that were taken on or very near the campus grounds. It is a virtual photographers paradise. The two top photos were taken after storms with the campus building roofs in sight. The next two are sunsets of the 10,000 foot Mt. Diablo (left a close up). The next two are of the Sea of Cortez looking North on the left in the afternoon and looking south in the early morning on the right. The next two are sunrises over the dunes looking East. The one on the bottom row on the left is a sunset to the West over the mountains while the bottom right is a very early sunrise with a half moon. # The Casa de Claro campus



Casa de Claro is in a constant process of development. It is located South of San Felipe on an acre of beach front facing the Sea of Cortez. People often camp out in the dunes on one of the five platforms that face the East or on the roof in what we call roofless rooms.



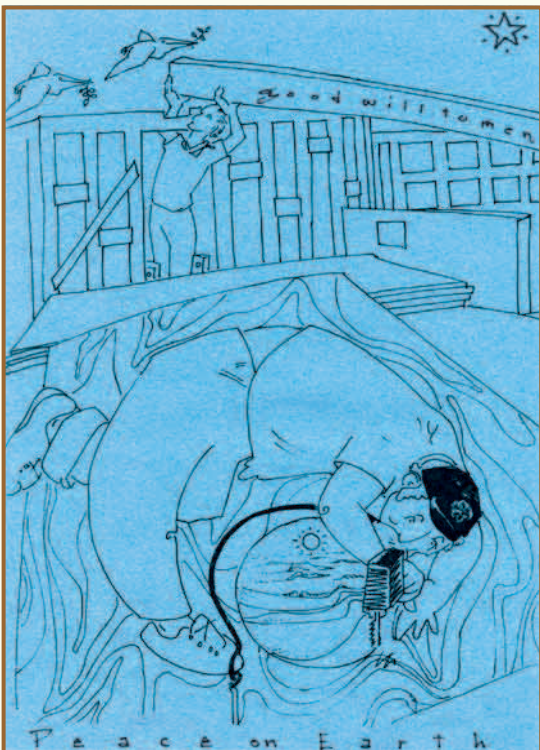
## The Casa de Claro art

## The Casa de Claro artists



Artists of all ages and from every discipline have come to the Casa de Claro to think, to feel, to become inspired and to do their work. They come as individuals, in small to large groups, and even with their whole families to include grand parents and extended family members and friends. We have indoor and outdoor facilities to accommodate a complete diversity of art forms and will soon have a complete digital facility that will include digital video and music. Power is supplied by solar energy. With prior arrangements workshops and day-care can be provided for children of all ages. The campus is located off the grid and in an area that is very remote so it is essential that these "remote" conditions be clearly understood before arrangements for a family can be properly made. Access to artists who have taken their families to the retreat are available for advice and a photo/video presentation can be made to create this essential understanding.

There is a very small food and ice store and a very good doctor within 3 miles of the campus but San Felipe (the nearest city) is a 30 to 45 minute drive.
